2015/16 MEMBERSHIP INFORMATION

2016/17 ANNUAL REGISTRATION FEE: \$65.00 (includes the AWGA dues for 2107) League play begins in January and runs through December for the 2016/17 season.

ANNUAL REGISTRATION FEE INCLUDES: Ladies League Perpetual Trophy/Plaque, Club Championship Trophy, Player of Year Prize Fund.

TOURNAMENT ENTRY FEES: Ladies Golf League players will be responsible to pay green fees as applicable during each tournament. In addition to the green fees charged by WSGC, each player will pay a tournament fee of *\$7.00 per day of competition*.

ENTRY FEES INCLUDES: The \$7.00 tournament fee includes \$5.00 prize fund for the play of the day pay out, \$2.00 closest to the pin prize. Must be paid in cash to the golf shop.

TOURNAMENT PAYOUT: The \$5.00 prize fund will be distributed by the WSGC in the form of Golf Shop Credit (Script) and will be held for each player in the golf shop. Approximately 25-30% of all players entering each tournament will receive prizes.

GREENS FEES: The golf shop staff will endeavor to minimize greens fees for all players during tournaments. Each player should understand that reductions in greens fees are conditional and have been established for Ladies Golf League events only and are not achievable during other times. May be paid to the golf shop by cash or credit card.

GOLF SHOP DISCOUNTS: Members of the Ladies Golf League will be given a discount of 10% for all non-sale merchandise and special order purchases in the golf shop and all food and beverage purchases in Mulligan's Grill. Does not apply to greens fees, range balls, cart fees, beverage cart or snack shack.

PLAYER OF THE YEAR PRIZES: Each player participating in each tournament will receive points towards the end of year prizes. Individual points will be awarded based on each player's score against their established handicap/projected score. The player that collects the most points throughout the calendar year will be declared the Player of The Year.

SIGN-UPS AND CANCELLATION POLICY: Deadline for each tournament sign-up is 6 PM the Wednesday prior to each tournament. Entries after the deadline will be at the discretion of the golf shop staff based on space availability. There is a 24-hour cancellation policy in affect for all events. Players cancelling after the deadline may be subject to future sign-up restrictions.

GROUPINGS AND TEE TIMES: In an effort to make sure players get an opportunity to play with other members of the Ladies Golf League, the golf shop staff will occasionally arrange the groupings. Each player may sign-up with one other member in which they would like to play for each tournament. All play will be in groups of 4 players or less (Groups of Five are not permitted). Every effort will be made to accommodate pairing requests based on the type of game being played, but the golf shop staff has the ultimate authority to modify pairings.

TOURNAMENT FORMATS: In an effort to make each event enjoyable for all skill levels, each tournament will have a different format for the prize fund. The format for each event will be set by the board and disclosed prior to play. Changes may be made to accommodate number of entries received on the day of play. There will be two types of individual tournaments – Individual Gross and Net (where a player plays golf keeping gross score) but scoring for the competition is done by points, special format, or by using a special game structure like fairways hit, greens hit, or numbers of putts used. Team Competitions will pair players of differing abilities to play in different formats such as scrambles, alternate shots, or best-ball, quotas, etc. Players are awarded end of year points for all competitions, but can only score bonus points during individual tournaments. Formats will allow for gross score to be recorded and posted for each tournament so that the score can be entered into the USGA and/or AWGA.

MAJOR TOURNAMENT: The Ladies Golf League will have one major tournament each year. The Club Championship will be a 2-day tournament. Participation in at least 4 previous tournaments during the year is required to qualify for winning the club championship title.

STATE MEDALLION: 4 events will be designated State Medallion qualifying rounds. The best 2 rounds of the 4 qualifying rounds will be used to determine the gross and net State Medallion winners for the league. Winners have the option to play in the AWGA State Medallion Tournament.

SCHEDULE: The tournament schedule and formats are subject to modification by the golf shop staff to accommodate tournaments and other conflicting events. Generally, the Ladies Golf League will play on two Sunday's each month, or as otherwise adjusted for over-seeding schedule and holidays.

TEE TIMES: Tee times will be posted in the golf shop and distributed by e-mail to all players 2 days before each tournament. Each player is responsible to be on-time for their time of starting. Players late for their starting time will be assessed a 2-stroke penalty for being late. Ladies shall arrive early enough to register in the golf shop, pay fees, and obtain the golf cart without delaying other players.

HANDICAPS: Each member of the Ladies Golf League will establish an AWGA/USGA handicap during the playing of events. A new member will be required to provide handicap info. AWGA, GHIN, SOCIAL, ETC. The first tournament Gross and net will be the 5% rule where the new members gross score cannot be lower than info by more than 5%. E.g. 12 handicap cannot shoot, or be credited with for payout purposes, a score of less than 80 gross, 68 net.

If a new member does not have a handicap they will play the first tournament at 90% of the first round. The second tournament will be played at the handicap of your first round with a proviso being the lowest net score will be 68 the same as for the new member with a handicap.

After two tournament rounds, 100% of your AWGA (rounded down) handicap will be applied. The maximum handicap to be used towards a net tournament score or a net skins game is 40.
